

CAMPING RULES AND REGULATIONS

Note: prices listed below are for passes purchased prior to the event.

All prices increase by \$10 at the gate.

VIP CAMPING There are 76 numbered, premier camping passes available for \$135.00 per spot. Each spot will be mowed and before you arrive. These are the best-viewing, up front spots and can be reserved and purchased online. VIP campers can arrive from 8am on Thursday, September 7th through 10pm Friday, September 8th. All campers will be guaranteed the exact spot they purchased. VIP campers **MUST** arrive by 10pm Friday, September 8th, or forfeit their VIP spot and will have to camp in the general admission campground. (NO REFUNDS) You can always check at the gate to see if there are any extra VIP spots that are open at that time.

EARLY RESERVED There are 36 numbered front row (along the hill climb ditch) camping passes available for \$105.00 per spot. Each spot will be mowed and marked before you arrive. These spots are farther from the hill, but they are also a little farther off the beaten path, which some people like, and are also near the security booth. Like the VIP's. EARLY RESERVED campers can arrive from 8am on Thursday, September 7th through 10pm on Friday, September 8th and will be guaranteed the exact spot that they purchased. Early Reserved campers **MUST** arrive by 10pm Friday, September 8th, or forfeit their VIP spot and will have to camp in the general admission campground. (NO REFUNDS)

EARLY GENERAL ADMISSION (GA) Early campers pay \$55.00 per spot and can select their own place in the GENERAL ADMISSION campground. (NOT any of the VIP or EARLY RESERVED spots) EARLY GA can arrive at the same time as the VIP and EARLY RESERVED campers, a day earlier than the regular GA, starting at 8am on Thursday, September 7th.

GENERAL ADMISSION (GA) GA camping passes are \$35.00 per vehicle on a first-come, first-serve basis. GA campers can begin entering the campground starting at 8am on Friday, September 8th, but **CANNOT** enter the campground until that time. If you are a GA camping pass-holder, please do **NOT** start lining up on the side of the road (all vehicles must clear the roadway) until **AFTER** 8pm on Thursday, September 7th.

TENT CAMPING is allowed and is \$35.00 per spot, the same as GA camping passes for motorhomes and camp trailers.

MOTORCYCLE CAMPING is \$35 per bike. The motorcycle campground remains in the same location as in previous years (see map). It opens at 8 am on Friday, September 8th. It involves

only 350 feet of off-pavement riding through grass and doesn't have any mud or tricky riding, so your bike won't get filthy.

PLEASE BE COURTEOUS TO YOU NEIGHBORS.

DOGS are allowed in the campground area only, and but **MUST BE LEASHED** at all times. PLEASE clean up after your dogs and place in the dumpsters. The **ONLY DOGS** that are allowed in the fenced spectators areas are service dogs and verified support animals **ON LEASH**.

CAMPFIRES are okay but **MUST BE** contained in a fire box, BBQ grill or fire pit. **ABSOLUTELY NO OPEN FIRES ON THE GROUND. IF CAUGHT YOU WILL ESCORTED OFF THE PROPERTY, AND/OR ARRESTED AND FINED.**

SPEED LIMIT There is a 15mph speed limit on all roads around the hillclimb. **ONLY** seniors, handicapped and veterans may bring 4-wheelers to get around on, as long as you obey the speed limit. **ALL OTHER, NON-RACING ATTENDEES, PLEASE KEEP YOUR 4-WHEELERS AND MINI BIKES AT HOME.** If you want to race around, please enter the hillclimb and race the hill.

NO FIREARMS, FIREWORKS OR ILLEGAL DRUGS WILL BE TOLERATED. IF CAUGHT, PUNISHMENT WILL FOLLOW ACCORDING TO THE LAW.

EXTRA VEHICLES ALL campers (VIP, Early Reserved, Early GA and GA) may purchase ONE additional vehicle pass for the campground (such as those used to run back and forth to town during the event) for a fee of \$10.00. The limit is one extra vehicle per camp spot. All extra vehicles must be within the designated camping spot which satisfies our ingress/egress safety requirements. If you want to park or camp with families or friends, please arrive at the same time.
