

CAMPING RULES AND REGULATIONS

SUPER VIP CAMPING– The spots are numbered 1- 75 and are on the front row behind the ditch. These can be purchased for a \$150.00 online or \$160.00 at the gate. Each spot will be mowed before you arrive on Thursday. The Super VIP and VIP's are the best viewing and can be purchased and reserved online. Both SUPER VIP's and VIP's can start arriving from 8am Thursday, September 12th through 10pm Friday, September 13th and will be guaranteed the exact spot the purchased. Campers who DO NOT arrive by 10pm Friday, September 13th, might NOT be given the SUPER VIP's or VIP's spot and might have to camp in the regular campground. (NO REFUNDS). You can always check at the gate to see if there any SUPER or VIP spots that are open.

VIP CAMPING– The spots are numbered 41-76. VIP camping passes are available for \$135.00 online and \$145.00 at gate per spot. All the same rules that apply to the SUPER VIP's apply to the VIP's.

RESERVED– The spots are numbered 76-112 front row (along the hill climb ditch) camping passes available for \$105.00 online and \$115.00 at gate per spot. Each spot will be mowed before you arrive. These spots are farther from the hill, but they are also a little farther off the beaten path, which some people like, and are also near the security booth. Like the VIP's, the Reserved campers can arrive from 8am Thursday, September 12th through 10pm on Friday, September 13th and will be guaranteed the exact spot that they purchased. Reserved campers who DO NOT arrive by 10pm on Friday September 13th might NOT be given their exact spot and might have to camp in the regular campground. (NO REFUNDS)

REGULAR– Early campers pay \$55.00 online and \$65.00 at gate per spot and can select their own place in the REGULAR campground. For these spots you can arrive starting at 8pm, Thursday evening, September 12th.

MOTORCYCLE CAMPING– The motorcycle campground remains in the same location as in previous years and is \$35.00 online and \$45.00 at the gate per bike. It opens at 8am on Friday, September 13th. It involves only 350 feet of off-pavement riding through the grass and doesn't have any tricky riding and your bike won't get filthy getting in.

TENT CAMPING– Tenting is allowed and it is \$35.00 online and \$45.00 at the gate. Fees are the same as regular camping passes for the motorhomes and camp trailers

DOGS– Dogs are okay in the campground but NEED to be on a LEASH at all times. Please clean up after your dog or dogs and place their waste in the dumpsters. **NO LOOSE DOGS AT ALL.**

The ONLY dogs allowed in the spectators area are health related service dogs.

CAMPFIRES– Campfires are okay, but **MUST BE** contained in a fire box, BBQ grille or a fire pit. Absolutely no open fires on the ground, IF CAUGHT YOU WILL BE ESCORTED OFF THE PROPERTY AND/OR ARRESTED AND FINED.

Speed limit—There is a 15 mph speed limit in and around the hillclimb. ONLY Seniors, Veterans and Handicapped are allowed to have 4-wheelers to get around on. ALL OTHER, NON-RACING ATTENDEES, PLEASE KEEP YOUR 4-WHEELERS AND MINI BIKES AT HOME. IF YOU WANT TO RACE AROUND, PLEASE ENTER THE HILLCLIMB AND RACE UP THERE.

NO FIREARMS, NO FIREWORKS OR ILLEGAL DRUGS AT ALL. IF CAUGHT THE LAW WILL INTERVENE AND PUNISHMENT WILL FOLLOW ACCORDING TO THE LAW.

EXTRA VEHICLES– All campers, whether SUPER VIP, VIP, RESERVED or REGULAR may bring one additional vehicle in the campground, such as those used to run back and forth to town during the event and must pay a lower fee of \$10.00 per vehicle. The limit is one extra vehicle per camp spot. All extra vehicles must be within the designated camping spot which satisfies our ingress/egress safety requirements. If you want to park or camp with families or friends please arrive at the same time. Be courteous to your neighbors. Please help to keep our camping clean and debris picked up. There will be dumpsters provided for this.
